Mission and Ministry Description

Admission

- A. Pray for God's will and direction in your child(ren)'s education.
- B. Obtain registration packet from calvarymiami.com/lhm.
- C. Submit completed registration packet and Registration Support.
- D. Attend the new family and student(s) enrollment meeting with Administration.
- E. Be timely in paying Academic Package costs and Ministry Support (Annual or Monthly).
- F. Adhere to State Requirements for homeschool student enrollment.
- G. Age Requirements: PreK3 students* must be at least 3 years old by the first day of school**
K5 students* must be five years old on or before 9/1/2023.

*Must be fully restroom-trained and self-sufficient in hygiene after restroom use at the time of enrollment

**Additional placement evaluation may be required.
